CALL FOR PAPERS

We are pleased to announce the Call for Papers for the International Conference ‘New Perspectives on Garcilaso de la Vega’/Congreso Internacional: Nuevas perspectivas sobre Garcilaso de la Vega to take place on **Thursday, 30th May 2024**.

This interdisciplinary conference will bring together scholars from the fields of Italian, Spanish and Classical Studies to present the most recent innovations in scholarship on the major sixteenth-century Spanish poet Garcilaso de la Vega. It will form the first professional collaboration between UK institutions and the international research group PRONAPOLI (<https://pronapoli.com/>). We are pleased to announce that Prof. Eugenia Fosalba (Universitat de Girona) will be the keynote speaker.

The conference will end with a book launch for Dr Rich Rabone’s monograph *Moderation and the Mean in the Literature of Spain's Golden Age: A Measure for Measure*.

Papers may address, but are not limited to, the following topics:

- The Neapolitan literary context of the first decades of the Cinquecento
- The relationship between Latin and the vernacular in sixteenth-century Naples
- Classical reception in the work of Garcilaso and his contemporaries
- The reception of Garcilaso in Spain

We invite abstract submissions for 15-minute presentations in English (to take place in person or online) from researchers at all stages.

Abstracts should consist of no more than 200 words and should be submitted by **Wednesday, 10th April 2024** to maria.czepiel@lincoln.ox.ac.uk. Applicants will be notified of acceptance by Wednesday 1st May 2024.
